

# IMPACT-PL

In the first two year of benefit administration, CT Paid Leave has provided over **\$687 million** in benefits to **more than 105,000 workers**. CT Paid Leave has received applications from **all 169 cities and towns**.

## BY THE NUMBERS:



**51 percent** of claims allow employees to address their own serious health condition.



**35 percent** of claims are related to pregnancy, childbirth or bonding with a new child.



**12 percent** of claims support employees to care for a family member with a serious health condition.

Claim decisions are made, on average, **3.1 days** after documentation is filed.

**92 percent** of claims issues are resolved with one phone call.
