

Legislative Update April 10, 2025

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SB 1427: An Act Expanding Paid Family and Medical Leave Insurance Program Benefits to Certain School Employees

- Testified in support during public hearing on March 4
 - Read testimony | Watch Erin's testimony (starts at 51:21)
- Joint Favorable Substitute (JFS) by Labor Committee on March 20; <u>File No. 542</u>
- Covers public and private school employees whose job does not require a certification/license under Chapter 166 under CT Paid Leave and CT FMLA
- Includes paraeducators, cafeteria workers, bus drivers, library aides, etc.



Additional Updates

- Collaboration with JB-OVS Victim Compensation Program
 - ➤ P.A. 24-5 allows victims of crime to receive CT Paid Leave and Victim's Compensation concurrently so long as the total benefit is not more than their regular pay
 - <u>▶ Op-ed</u> in recognition of National Crime Victims' Rights Week
- Legislator newsletter: includes monthly updates, links to recent media and map showing the number of claims by town
 - ► January: 57.5% open rate
 - ➤ February: 89.7% open rate
 - ➤ March: 95.2% open rate
