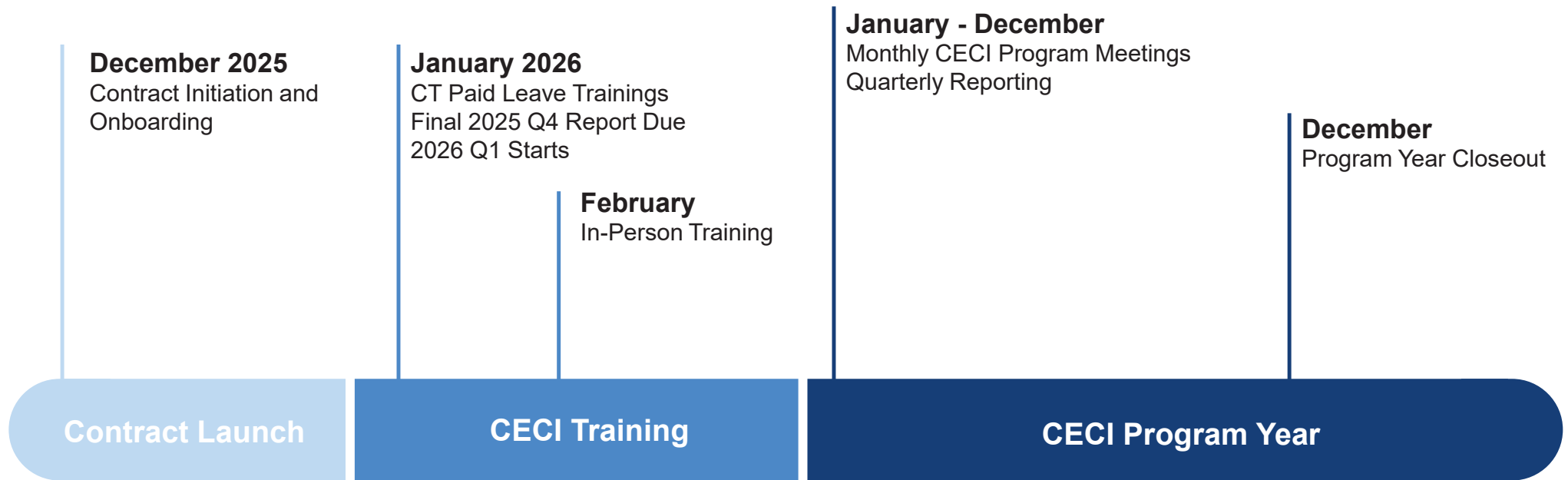


# Community Education Coordinators Initiative 2025 Update

- Final Quarter 4 Reports are due January 31<sup>st</sup>.
- 2025 work done so far:
  - 460 Events, workshops, trainings, attended/hosted by the CECs
    - 186 in Quarter 3
  - 326 People received application assistance in Total
    - 38.65% were for Medical Leave
    - 39.57% were for Caregiver Leave
    - 18.10% were for Bonding Leave

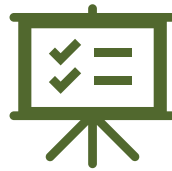
# 2026 Program Updates

## Streamlined Reporting Template

Based on feedback and after using the 2025 reporting form, the 2026 Quarterly Reporting Form is updated to streamline and clarify reporting for the CECs

Instead of having them input summaries of numbers, they can directly record information for everyone they provide application assistance to and each event they attend

More consistent reporting, reduces errors, and reduces burden of reporting on contractors



## More channels for information sharing

Provided a shared spreadsheet that CECs can share events they anticipate attending (events attended will be documented in their Quarterly Reports). The Authority will also include their events in this document also.
